Restricted Access Monitoring at Hospital

- Active healthcare center in dynamic, urban environment with hundreds of workers
- Close proximity to existing patient tower
- Supervisors receive realtime notifications when workers enter the offlimits area

Window Cradle Station Fleet


- Site has 24 window washing stations for caulking
- Subcontractors claiming there were no open stations
- Introduced POI to identify open stations in real-time, improving caulking rates by 35%

Hoist Wait Times

- POI statically mounted where workers are waiting for hoists
- Measure amount of time workers are idly spending in line to optimize the number of hoists you have
- Identify critical path labor or material bottlenecks at hoists to stay on schedule

Unauthorized Access at K-12 School

- Active private school renovation
- 7 areas of access between the site and school affixed with POI
- Superintendent receives real-time notifications when worker enters one of the above access areas
